

ADULT VACCINES

HPV-Gardasil

\$205.00 (\$210.00 Non-Resident)

HPV vaccine is approved by FDA and is recommended by CDC for both males and females. It is routinely given at 11 or 12 years of age, but it may be given beginning at age 9 years through age 26 years. Most adolescents 9 through 14 years of age should get HPV vaccine as a two-dose series with the doses separated by 6-12 months. People who start HPV vaccination at 15 years of age and older should get the vaccine as a three-dose series with the second dose given 1-2 months after the first dose and the third dose given 6 months after the first dose. There are several exceptions to these age recommendations. Your health care provider can give you more information.

Hepatitis A & Hepatitis B

\$105.00 (\$110.00 Non-Resident)

Hepatitis is common in adults, you should receive this vaccine if you have chronic liver disease, work with infected animals.

Receive if recommended by your doctor.

IPV-Polio

\$50.00 (\$55.00 Non-Resident)

Given to adults traveling to countries where polio is common.

Receive if recommended by your doctor.

Meningococcal-(MCV4)

Menactra

\$130.00 (\$135.00 Non-Resident)

Meningitis is life threatening and contagious. MCV4 can prevent four types of meningococcal disease, which make up about 70% of the cases in the U.S. The MCV4 is preferred for people age 55 and younger. The CDC requires one dose at age 11 and a second at age 16. The CDC recommends MCV4 for anyone 55 and under traveling to high risk areas, military recruits, exposed patients, and people with certain immune disorders.

MMR-Measles, Mumps, Rubella

\$75.00 (\$80.00 Non-Resident)

Adults born after 1957 who have not received vaccine.

Receive if recommended by your doctor.

Pneumococcal-Preunar13-Pneumonia

\$195.00 (\$200.00 Non-Resident)

"Pneumonia Shot" for adults under 65 with certain health conditions and for all adults 65 and older, ask your doctor which pneumonia shot is right for you.

Pneumococcal-Pneumovax23-Pneumonia

\$100.00 (\$105.00 Non-Resident)

"Pneumonia Shot" for adults 65 years of age and older.

TB -Tuberculosis Test

\$25.00 (\$30.00 Non-Resident)

Must return 48-72 hours for test reading results.

Tdap-Boostrix

\$55.00 (\$60.00 Non-Resident)

Some adults should receive a tetanus booster dose that also includes protection against pertussis (whooping cough), including those with close contact to infants less than a year old.

Shingles-Zostavax

\$210.00 (\$215.00 Non-Resident)

Adults over 60 years of age. The same virus that causes chickenpox stays in your body and can later resurface as Shingles- a painful, blistering rash.

Receive if recommended by your doctor.

Varicella-Chicken Pox

\$125.00 (\$130.00 Non-Resident)

Adults who have never had chickenpox disease or have a weekend immune system caused by disease or medication.

Receive if recommended by your doctor.
