Information

Immunization clinics are held monthly at the Orland Township office, where free vaccines are administered to residents 18 and under; eligibility restrictions apply.*

A parent or legal guardian must accompany a child unless special arrangements are made with the Health Services department prior to the clinic.

*Requirements:

- An up-to-date U.S. immunization record for each child is mandatory.
- Medicaid/All Kids cards will be checked through Medi system.
- A parent's photo ID, passport and proof of residency is required.
- Live in Cook County.

Eligibility

- * Medicaid (Title 19) - VFC
No Charge
- * Native American or Alaska Native — VFC
No charge
- * No Insurance living in Orland Township - VFC
No Charge
- * Underinsured (private insurance does not cover vaccines, policy must be shown) living in Orland Township—VFC
No Change
- * Medicaid (Title 21) /All Kids - Copays if applicable -required at time of service
- * No Insurance or underinsured living outside Orland Township—\$30 per vaccine. Cash or Credit Card only
