# Immunization Clinic

## Information

Immunization clinics are held monthly at the Orland Township office, where free vaccines are administered to Orland Township residents 18 and under; eligibility restrictions apply. \*

A parent or legal guardian must accompany a child unless special arrangements are made with the Health Services department prior to the clinic.

\*Requirements:

- An up-to-date U.S. immunization record for each child is mandatory.
- Medicaid cards will be checked through Medi system. **Only** Title XIX (19) Medicaid eligible for VFC.
- A parent/legal guardian photo ID, passport and proof of residency is required.

## \*Eligibility For VFC Vaccines

- \* Live in Orland Township
- \* Medicaid Title XIX (19)
- \* Native American or Alaska Native
- \* No Insurance
- \* Underinsured ( insurance does not cover vaccines, policy must be shown)

**\*Please note—anyone who meets the above requirements but lives outside of Orland Township boundaries will be charged a \$20 administration fee per vaccine. Cash / Credit Only.**

**Orland Township is no longer accepting Medicaid Title XXI (21) All/Kids State Insurances.**
