## Vaccines for Children (VFC) Information

Immunization clinics are held monthly at the Orland Township office, where the vaccines are administered to Orland Township residents 18 and under; eligibility restrictions apply.\*

A parent or legal guardian must accompany a child unless special arrangements are made with the Health Services department prior to the clinic.

### \*Requirements:

- Every child must bring an up-to-date U.S. immunization record.
- All Medicaid cards will be checked through Medi system. **Only** Title XIX (19) Medicaid is eligible for VFC.
- A parent/legal guardian photo ID, passport and proof of residency is required.

### \*Eligibility For VFC Vaccines

- \* Live in Orland Township
- \* Medicaid Title XIX (19)
- \* Native American or Alaska Native
- \* No Insurance
- \* Underinsured (insurance does not cover vaccines, policy must be shown)

Orland Township can no longer accept :  
Medicaid Title XXI(21) or State-Funded /(CHIP)

**Please note: a \$10 administration fee per vaccine will be charged to Township residents (proof of residency required); non-residents will be charged a \$20 administration fee per vaccine. Payment is due at the time of the vaccine(s), cash or credit only.**
