## **Orland Township Food Pantry in Need of Donations** *Drive-thru donation drive scheduled for Friday, July 31*

After holding several highly attended grocery distributions, Orland Township is asking for community assistance in restocking the shelves of the Food Pantry, according to the office of Township Supervisor Paul O'Grady.

During each of the distribution events, the Township Food Pantry gave out more than 500 boxes packed with perishable and non-perishable grocery items, cases of water, paper towels, toilet paper and gift cards to residents in need due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

However, due to unprecedented food demand because of skyrocketing unemployment amid the coronavirus pandemic, food donations go out as quickly as they come into the pantry. Additionally, grocery store donations to the Township Food Pantry have dropped in recent weeks. In order to keep up with demand in this time of uncertainty, Orland Township is asking residents who are able to donate non-perishable food items.

"We were very fortunate to be able to assist so many families during this difficult time," said Supervisor O'Grady. "We need to be able to keep assisting residents, so we are asking those in the community who are able, to donate to the food pantry so we can help residents keep food on their tables."

Non-perishable items are needed. Those items include: boxed stuffing, cake mix, boxed/canned broth, canned chicken, canned fruit, canned tuna, cereal, dry potatoes, jelly, mac and cheese, pasta, pasta sauce, peanut butter, rice, soup, and grocery store gift cards.
