Donations of new, unwrapped items are needed. There is always a need is for gift items for pre-teens, teens and adults. Some suggested items are:

- Winter clothing in teen and adult sizes
- Grooming / shaving kits
- Hygiene products (body washes and lotions, shampoos, deodorants)
- Beauty supplies (make-up, perfumes/colognes, hair supplies, nail kits)
- Craft kits (jewelry making, art supplies, STEM for middle and high school)
- Stress relieving activity kits (coloring books for adults, paint-by-number sets)
- Board games / puzzles
- Blankets
