2025 ORLAND TOWNSHIP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicants must reside within the boundaries of Orland Township.
- 2. Immediate family members of the Board of Trustees, committee members of the Scholarship Foundation and employees of Orland Township are not eligible to participate in the scholarship competition.
- 3. Applicants must be graduating high school seniors.
- 4. Applicants may be called upon for a personal interview with the Board of Directors.
- 5. Award winners must enroll as full-time students at a college, university, trade or vocational school.
- 6. The scholarship selection committee awards the scholarship and reserves the right to disqualify any individual who does not meet the established criteria. All decisions are final.
- 7. The scholarships will be awarded based upon a combination of the applicant's leadership, volunteerism, academic focus, participation in extracurricular activities, recommendations from a school representative, volunteer supervisor or employer, as well as the essay and the information provided within the application. Financial hardship will be given strong consideration.
- 8. Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the college, university, trade or vocational school of the recipient will be attending and must be used for tuition, books or fees only.
- 9. Applications must be filled out entirely, and returned to the Orland Township Scholarship Foundation, 14807 Ravinia Avenue, Orland Park, IL 60462. **The deadline for filing is Friday, March 28, 2025 by 4:30 p.m.**
